Subjects Covered

- They won't correct errors. You will have to make actual corrections for yourself.
- They won't assist with graded take-home assignments or quizzes.
- They won't guarantee all answers are correct.
- They won't be judgmental about your work.



If walk-in hours become crowded, the Peer Tutor will circulate among students, helping them with their work. She will do the best she can to continue working with you until you are comfortable with your work.
