## The Writing Center

The Edgewood College Writing Center provides an entryway to academic discourse for students at all levels, in all disciplines. Located in DeRicci 206, we serve approximately a thousand students a year. The Writing Center is run by Writing Specialist Angela Woodward and staffed by undergraduate peer tutors who have been recommended by faculty and trained in a collaborative approach. Tutors work with students to help them improve their own writing. The Writing Center is appropriate for students of any level of writing ability, from advanced students in upper level courses to flummoxed beginners.

The Writing Center is free for all students, and operates on a drop-in basis, no appointment necessary. Students do not need a referral to use the Writing Center. However, the encouragement of an instructor is often key. Please talk to your classes about using the Writing Center.
