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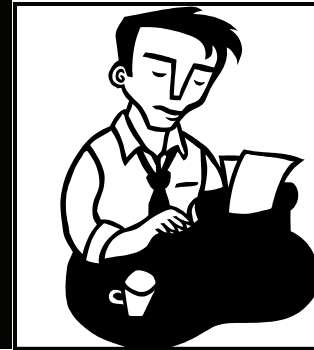

Why use the Writing Center?

Even excellent writers seek help from the Writing Center. Writing Center tutors provide feedback and answer your questions, help you to clarify your ideas, work with you on organization and flow, and make sure your writing is doing what you want it to do.

Who can use the Writing Center?

Any Edgewood student in any program, undergraduate or graduate, can use the Writing Center, with work from any class. You can also bring other writing, such as letters or scholarship applications. Last year, the Writing Center logged almost a thousand visits, and students from virtually every department on campus came in.

Who are our tutors?

Writing Center tutors are excellent undergraduate students, strong writers themselves, from a variety of majors, including nursing, education, and psychology.

How do we work?

Usually you will read your paper aloud to the tutor and then discuss revisions, starting with major issues and moving to details.

How long does it take?

Anywhere from ten minutes to an hour, depending on what you bring.

The Writing Center is easy to use

All hours are drop-in. No appointment is necessary. You do not need to be referred by your instructor.

Bring a partial paper

You do not need to have finished your paper to benefit from reading it with a tutor. Don't wait til the last minute. You can get valuable feedback on a work you are halfway through, or make plans for a paper you haven't even begun. Expect to make revisions, and leave time to get them done.

Ease your writing process

Find writing very slow or difficult? You can discuss your writing process with the tutor, and perhaps learn ways to make writing easier and more enjoyable.

Whether you are a proficient writer or a struggling one, you'll get something out of using the Writing Center.
